

UNESCO Global Geopark Mt. Apoi Climbing and Experience History and Culture in Hidaka



The Hidaka area in Hokkaido is located in the center and south of Hokkaido. You will find a unique alpine plant communities that were nurtured by such as mountains and valleys, special soil conditions consisting of a variety of peridotite unique in the world. The volcanic ash from the eruption and the special terrain of the coast have created natural harbors and pastures, and produced a history and culture that has prospered as a base for trade and horse production since past times.

In this tour, you can get experiences the history and culture of horses through horse riding experience and a tour of Japan's largest racehorse breeding ranch. It also includes a special plan for trekking Mt. Apoi, which joined the UNESCO Global Geopark in 2015. The Mt. Apoi Geopark has many legends of the indigenous Ainu people related to mysterious rocks, and at the beginning of the tour, we will stop by a museum to learn about the history of the Ainu people.

September is a cool and comfortable season with an average temperature of about 15 degrees Celsius, and it is the best season to have delicious foods, as it is called "Autumn appetite" in Japan. Join and spend exciting days in all areas of culture, activities and food!

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Highlights:

- Climbing Mt. Apoi of the Horoman peridotite, which was constructed 13 million years ago
- By climbing Mt. Apoi, learn about the special natural system and local history and culture.
- Learn and experience the history and culture of horses


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Route map



Day-by-day Itinerary

Day 1 –Night at the largest airport in Hokkaido

The night before the tour starts, we will spend time at a hotel directly connected to New Chitose Airport, the largest airport in Hokkaido. A traveling guide is waiting for you at the hotel's dedicated tour desk.

You will have an individual private single room. All rooms have WC and Shower, TV and Wi-Fi. included breakfast for the next morning(no dinner). In addition, the airport is fully equipped with restaurants and shops, as well as movie theaters and hot spring facilities, so refresh yourself after journey.

Day 2 – Indigenous Ainu Museum and Horse Riding Experience

JTB (travel agency) tour guide will pick you up at your hotel in the morning (8:30 am). Take a private car and arrive at the Indigenous Ainu Museum in about 1 hour and 15 minutes. Before the tour, you will receive a lecture from the museum curator. You will learn the Ainu tradition in a multifaceted and professional manner, including the wisdom and teachings nurtured in the background of the rich natural environment. The tour will be enriched by touching the Ainu culture here. After the museum, we will travel for about an hour and have lunch at a local restaurant. Enjoy Hidaka kelp Umami soup, Hidaka matured deer shabu-shabu with tomato, etc. Hidaka kelp is a famous kelp that can be obtained in this Hidaka area and is the source of UMAMI. After lunch, travel for about an hour and check in the hotel. The hotel was built in the middle of Mother Nature aiming for a space where horses, people and nature can interact. Everyone will have a thoroughbred horseback riding experience here. After the horse riding experience, our mountain guide will lecture you on trekking for the next day in the hotel. For dinner, a local fishmonger will deliver fresh seafood to the hotel for you to enjoy. Before bedtime, check the trekking equipment for the next day.

During dinner, enjoy watching fish cutting demonstration in front of you, they will be served as sashimi or seafood bowl. Available various other dishes.

Activity: Horse Riding / 60 min

Difficulty: 1/5

Day 3 – A story of the nature and people, connected by gifts from the mother earth.

After buffet-style breakfast, leave the hotel at 8:15 heading to the Mt. Apoi for 30 minutes. Arriving at the trailhead of Mt. Apoi, the adventure of the day gets started.

Learn the basic history and geographical features of the entire Geopark at the visitor center, then start trekking with a qualified international mountain guide. Mt. Apoi is 810 m high, the trekking distance is Approx.10km, Approx.5 hr.

After an hour trekking, get to the limit of forest presence on Mt. Apoi. The trail's steepest long rocky slope continues from here to the ridge next resting area.

The ridge area affords views of the Pacific Ocean to the south and ridges of the distant Hidaka Mountains to the north. Alpine flowers bloom freely along the trail from here to the summit. The summit is surrounded by Erman's birch trees. It's time for lunch here, enjoy a bakery set from local shop.

After lunch, descent from the mountain Approx. 2 hr. return to the visitor center again and end of trekking. Back to the hotel Approx. 30min. then enjoy soaking in the large public bath to get relaxed at the hotel. Dinner is at a local Indian restaurant, Approx.10 minutes drive.

Activity: Trekking / Mt. Apoi 810 m high / Approx.10km / Approx.5 hr.

Difficulty: 3/5

Day 4– Departure for Home

After breakfast, at 7:45am, head to JRA Hidaka Breeding Ranch, one of the largest racehorse breeding ranches in Japan, by private car. Great opportunity to learn about the coexistence of residents, horses, and the community through horse riding training at a jockey training school and a riding park, which is a town-run facility.

After that, transfer to Urakawa Town-run Horseback Riding Park and experience the horseback riding treatment that the local government is actively working on. Horseback riding medical treatment is an activity for people with special needs, such as disabled or the elderly people. At a jockey restaurant on a racehorse ranch, enjoy healthy lunch with calorie-calculated health-conscious menus.

After lunch, drive to Sapporo, the venue of ATWS. On the way, we will pop-in to the Sun Forest Dimasio Museum, Approx.1.5 hours away. Frenchman Gerard Dimasio was impressed by the scenery of the Thoroughbred ranch in Hidaka and visited Hidaka many times. Exhibits more than 200 works, including the world's largest oil painting, 9m high and 27m wide. After that, return to Sapporo Approx. 2 hr. drive.

Air Terminal Hotel: Single room with private bathroom. WiFi available

Also the large communal bath in New Chitose Airport is available for free.

Weather Conditions

The weather in Hidaka has many rainy days in September, and it can get very cold in the morning and evening. You may feel chilly, so it is safe to have a thick coat such as a fleece or raincoat. The average temperature is 15°C, mostly between 20°C. Also, since Mt. Apoi is low in altitude, it is a mountain that you can enjoy climbing on a day trip, but steep rocks may continue from the middle and the weather may change often and quickly, so let's enjoy climbing with perfect equipment.
