Day 1 – Gathering at Wilderness Lodge Hickory Wind

Welcome to Hokkaido! On your arrival in Kushiro Airport at 1pm, we warmly greet you at the airport will depart to "Hickory Wind".

Let's do an introduction of your guides before the tour starts.

Hickory Wind a lodge run by Mr. Makoto Ando and Mrs. Shinobu Ando. The lodge is like a home for this trip and all breakfasts and dinners will be served here.

Mr. Ando is a nature guide who has been sharing the stories of wildlife in East Hokkaido with people for over 20 years. He is well versed in wildlife, natural ecology and the history and culture of the region. With his years of experience, he is able to recognize the preferences of each tourists and provide the best nature experience for you. He is also a professional photographer who has won awards in world photography contests. If you want to take high-level photos, despite having a professional camera or smartphone, just ask him for advice during your trip.

Day 2 - Japanese Red Crane Observation and snowshoeing

We will leave the lodge at 6:00 a.m. to The Setsuri river.

The Setsuri River does not freeze over in winter, and the area becomes a precious roosting place for Japanese red cranes. In early winter morning, Mr. Ando will guide you to the special secret spot where you can see the cranes roosting together and moving slowly on the riverbed. Also you can enjoy the beautiful pink light with the steaming river.

Breakfast

Japanese Congee for a warm and comforting breakfast at lodge.

After breakfast, we will have snowshoeing in Kushiro Marshland.

During winter when the vast Kushiro Marshland is covered in a thick blanket of snow. Put on your TSL snowshoes across the fields of snow into the forests and enjoy the beautiful winter snow scape. Mr. Ando will show you how to look for Ural owl nest holes and other animals by using the high quality Swarovski optik scopes.

If you are lucky, you may even get to see Ezo Owls, Ezo deers, Black woodpeckers, Longtailed tits and Red foxes.

You will have one of Japan's specialties — Kushiro Ramen for lunch at "Jin". The noodles will be served in organic soup. You will enjoy every single drop of it.

After lunch, heading back to Lodge Hickory Wind to take a short break or enjoy the Onsen hot spring to get rid of your fatigue here.

Day 3 – Enjoy birdwatching in Shunkunitai Wild Bird Sanctuary

We will leave the lodge at 6:30 a.m. to Nemuro. After 2 hours driving, we will arrive in Nemuro City where you will have birdwatching.

Shunkunitai is known as a wild animal paradise. It is surrounded by the water and has various natural habitats therefore various species of birds, animals, insects and plants can live here, which you might encounter as well as Japanese red cranes, Swans, Steller's sea eagles and White-tailed Eagles in Shunkunitai by using the high quality Swarovski optik scopes.

Lunch

Lunch at Akkeshi Gourmet Park Restaurant "Conchiglie".

You can roast your own oysters on the shell and enjoy grilled oysters, seafood, vegetables and other local ingredients.

Akkeshi is the only place in Japan where oysters are available all year round. Lake Akkeshi, which is a mixture of freshwater rivers containing nutrients from the mountains and marshlands and seawater from the Pacific Ocean, is a blessed natural environment that makes oysters grow plump and sweet.

Before heading back to lodge, you can buy souvenirs at the Akkeshi Fisheries Association direct sales shop.

Dinner

Seafood Okonomiyaki with Tsurui Cheese will be served.

Tsurui Cheese has won the All Japan Natural Cheese Contest for the six time in succession.

Mrs. Shinobu will show you how to make "Okonomiyaki" and it just makes the experience that much more exceptional.

• Kushiro: Kushiro City General Hospital, about 40-minute drive away.

• Nemuro: Nemuro City Hospital, about 30-minute drive away.

Spring in Kushiro is often characterized by cyclical changes in sunny and rainy days. Occasionally, the characteristics of winter and summer appear, and weather changes are significant, such as sudden rises and falls in temperature, unseasonably heavy snow and rain, and strong winds. In the summer, the fog season starts, and it is a natural summer retreat, as it is cooler than Sapporo and Obihiro, with no noticeable rise in temperature. When autumn arrives, the weather is neither hot nor cold, the air is dry, and the weather is refreshing. And in winter, the days are sunny, the air is dry and windy. Although Kushiro is located on the coast, the temperature is quite cool. The days are sunny, but the wind is strong.
